

Rubric for a general non-fiction book report

First make a cover sheet for your book report. You need your name, your period, and the date. You may decorate it as you like.

The first page of the book report begins with the BIBLIOGRAPY of the book: example

Greene, Lawrence J. Smater Kids. Los Angeles: The Body Press.

1987, 203 pages.

Then in sentence form list five new facts you learned from reading this book.

After that write in sentence form five things that you already knew about this subject before reading the book.

The third thing you need to do is write six new vocabulary words with their definitions.

A fourth thing you need to do is to tell two opinions stated in this book.

The fifth thing is to write a two-three paragraph summary of your book.

The sixth thing is to write the most interesting fact or piece of information you found in this book; then tell why this is the most interesting fact.

Finally would you recommend this book? Why or why not?
